



## Health certificate

The undersigned,	

states that the following animals:

From owner:	

1. Are free of clinical signs of any contagious disease and are in good health. The animals are in good condition.
2. The animals are checked for mites with negative result.
3. The animals come from a holding where the general health is good and where the animals are regularly dewormed and vaccinated. The animals are treated with an antiparasiticum (i.e. ivermectine) at least two times in the last 14 days prior to the show.
4. When the animals come from abroad they are tested for brucellosis and tuberculosis, or coming from a free area of tuberculosis and met all requirements set by the E.U. government for transport of animals within the E.U. A copy of the export certificate will be handed to the chief veterinarian on the show.
